ORDINANCE NO. 2012-02

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF NORTH MIDDLETON AMENDING CHAPTER 196-15 ENTITLED PARKING PROHIBITED AT ALL TIMES IN CERTAIN LOCATIONS.

The Board of Supervisors of North Middleton Township hereby ordains as follows:

Section 1. Amendment to the Code.

Chapter 196, entitled Vehicles and Traffic, Ordinance No. 196-15 is hereby amended to include the text of this Ordinance appearing hereinafter.

Section 2. Text of Amendment.

Chapter 196, Article III, Section 196-15 entitled Parking Prohibited At All Times in Certain Locations, shall be amended to include the western side of Charles Street.

Section 3. Intent.

It is intended that parking shall be prohibited at all times on the west side of Charles Street.

Section 4. Format.

The formatting of this Amendment to Ordinance No. 196-15 is hereby delegated to the publisher of the Code to be consistent with existing Code provisions.

Section 5. The provisions of this Ordinance are severable. Should any part of the Ordinance be declared by final court order with jurisdiction to be illegal or otherwise invalid, the balance of the Ordinance shall be unaffected by such declaration

Section 6. This Ordinance shall become effective by operation of law pursuant to the Second Class Township Code of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.
