

**NORTH MIDDLETON TOWNSHIP
CUMBERLAND COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA**

ORDINANCE NO. 2012-03

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF NORTH MIDDLETON CUMBERLAND COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, ESTABLISHING A TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDINANCE FOR TRUCK TRAFFIC UTILIZING MEADOWBROOK ROAD IN THE TOWNSHIP AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Board of Supervisors of North Middleton Township, Cumberland County, Pennsylvania, it is hereby enacted and ordained as follows:

Section 1. Short Title

The Ordinance shall be known as the Meadowbrook Road Truck Length Traffic Regulation Ordinance.

Section 2. Definitions and Interpretations

a. Words and phrases, when used in this Ordinance, except where otherwise specifically provided, shall have the meanings ascribed to them in the Pennsylvania Vehicle Code (The Act of June 17, 1976, P.L. 162, No. 8) as amended, except that in this Ordinance the word "street" or "road" may be used interchangeably with the word "highway" and shall have the same meaning as the word "highway" as described in the Pennsylvania Vehicle Code.

b. In this Ordinance, the singular shall include the plural, the plural shall include the singular and masculine shall include the feminine.

Section 3. Continuation of Prior Regulations

The provisions of this Ordinance, so far as they are the same as those of Ordinances in force prior to the adoption of this Ordinance, are intended as a continuation of such Ordinances and Regulations and not as new enactments. The provisions of this Ordinance shall not affect any act done or liability incurred, nor shall they affect any suit or prosecution pending or to be instituted to enforce any right or penalty or to punish any offense under such Ordinances or Regulations as aforesaid.

Section 4. Temporary and Emergency Suspensions.

The Township Supervisors or Chief of Police shall have the power to temporarily suspend this Ordinance in the time of emergency.

Section 5. Regulation of Length of Vehicles Utilizing Meadowbrook Road

It shall be unlawful for any truck traffic utilized for hauling, transporting, delivery or carrying of commercial goods which exceeds thirty (30) feet in length to utilize Meadowbrook Road between Newville Road and Distribution Drive within North Middleton Township, Cumberland County,

Pennsylvania, excepting only local deliveries for businesses located along and having vehicular access only from Meadowbrook Road.

Any person who violates this provision of the Ordinance shall be sentenced to pay a fine of not less than Two Hundred Dollars (\$200.00) together with costs of court and costs of prosecution.

Section 6. Signage

North Middleton Township shall, upon the passage of this Ordinance and prior to enforcement, ensure that proper signage is placed to give proper notification to all vehicular traffic of this size/length limitation on Meadowbrook Road.

Section 7. Authority of Police Officers

Police officers of the Township of North Middleton shall have the authority to take all necessary measures to enforce this Ordinance in accordance with North Middleton Township Code and the Pennsylvania Vehicle Code.

Section 8. Severability


The provisions of this Ordinance are severable. Should any part of the Ordinance be declared by final court order with jurisdiction to be illegal or otherwise invalid, the balance of the Ordinance shall be unaffected by such declaration

Section 9. Effective Date

This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force five (5) days after is enactment by the Board of Supervisors of North Middleton Township, Cumberland County, Pennsylvania as provided by law.




The Board of Supervisors of North Middleton Township will hold a hearing to take public comment on proposed Ordinance No. 2012-03, entitled AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF NORTH MIDDLETON CUMBERLAND COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, ESTABLISHING A TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDINANCE FOR TRUCK TRAFFIC UTILIZING MEADOWBROOK ROAD IN THE TOWNSHIP AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS. The hearing will take place at 6:40 p.m. on Thursday, March 1, 2012, or any other time which the Public Hearing may be continued by the Board of Supervisors, at the North Middleton Township Municipal Building, 2051 Spring Road, Carlisle, Pennsylvania 17013.


